The Department of Chemistry at Southern Methodist University (SMU), Dallas, Texas offers an open rank **THEORETICAL CHEMISTRY** position (tenure track Assistant Professor or Associate/Full Professor with tenure) starting August 1, 2019. Applicants must have a Ph.D. in Theoretical Chemistry or a related discipline. The successful candidate i) is expected to engage in the new Theoretical Chemistry PhD program; therefore, competence in teaching Theoretical/Quantum Chemistry at the graduate levels is mandatory; ii) must demonstrate an outstanding record of research and external funding (Associate/Full Professor level), or will establish a high impact, fundable research program (Assistant Professor level) complementing the current research in Theoretical Chemistry at the Department of Chemistry; iii) will strongly benefit from the excellent high performance computing facilities available on the SMU campus.
